## Lesson idea: The weather

| Age group                      | 12-13   |
|--------------------------------|---|
| Language                       | French/German/Spanish (beginners)   |
| Topic                          | The weather   |
| Expected Learning Outcomes     | Pupils will be able to: Use their knowledge of weather phrases to present a weather forecast using the Target Language.   |
| Digital technology activity    | The pupils use Touchcast Studio App 'Annotate Images' option to insert a map of their chosen country and weather symbols. They then type a script onto the auto cue and use this to record their weather forecast moving their symbols to the correct place on the map as they describe the weather for each chosen city (max 5)  |
| Digital technology resource(s) | Google images<br>Touchcast Studio App   |
| Duration of activity           | Homework (once weather phrases have been learned)   |
| Assessment                     | Pupils are given an assessment grade indicating what must be included and are also assessed on the quality of their spoken Target Language. This piece may be assessed by the teacher or by a peer and then a sample is moderated by the teacher.   |
| Links to Bloom's Taxonomy      | Remember: recall the vocabulary and phrases for describing the weather  Understand: be able to describe the weather in different cities on a map of the country  Apply: prepare an animated video presentation as if they were weather forecasters on television  Analyse: break down the various steps in the creation process to be able to use the app effectively (find clipart for maps, weather symbols, prepare a script in the target language)  Evaluate: Review one's own work before submission against a list of fixed criteria and then using this same criteria evaluate their classmates' work (peer assessment)  Create a video presentation to produce a weather forecast in the Target Language using the app |
